TWA Liner From London Landed Here

A Trans-World Airlines Super Constellation carrying 41 passengers and a crew of 10 landed at Hector Airport shortly before noon today when trouble developed in one of its four engines.

Capt. C. O. Miller of Kansas City said he had stopped at Winnipeg to refuel and that when he was airborne, a warning signal flashed from the engine and he decided to land here.

The ship took off from London and was bound for San Francisco via the Polar route.

Miller said there was no fire.

Miller indicated that another ship would be sent here from Kansas City to continue on with the passengers.

The passengers had not been checked through U. S. Customs and remained under quarantine aboard plane for some time. They left the plane to eat lunch but remained in the terminal awaiting the arrival of the replacement plane.

An airport spokesman said the plane still had not arrived at 2:30 p.m.
