Patsy Carol Nuckols, 70, of Visalia, California, was called home to our Lord on March 21, 2016. Patsy was born on July 22, 1945, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Herbert Hillary Keathley and Ruby Nadene (Bonds) Keathley.
